65. CHAMPAGNE LALLIER R.020   Aye France		
A multi-vintage brut that is fresh and fruity, balanced with minerality and brioche. As part of the Réflexion series, it is reinterpreted annually to reflect the character of the harvest, with the R20 featuring the 2020 vintage as its base. So, so good.	67	
66. MOËT & CHANDON BRUT IMPÉRIAL NV  Epernay France		
Created in 1869, Brut Imperial is the house’s iconic Champagne. Grapes from 280 of the 319 crus in Champagne and aged for 24 months in their cellar. Worldwide, one bottle is opened every ten seconds. They’re doing something right!	15	85
67. MOËT & CHANDON ROSÉ IMPÉRIAL NV  Epernay France		
The intensity of the Pinot Noir (40 - 50%) with the roundness of the Pinot Meunier (30 - 40%) finished with the elegance of the Chardonnay (10 - 20%). Lighter in colour than some rose Champagne styles. Very elegant.	95	
68. LAURENT-PERRIER CUVÉE ROSÉ Tour-sur-Marne France		
This champagne with its distinctive bottle is one for connoisseurs. Using only Pinot Noir from grand cru villages and the more unusual soak-on-the-skins method, LP Rosé is surely one of the most sort after rosé Champagnes on the market today.	135	
69. RUINART BLANC DE BLANCS Reims France		
This blend brings together a balance of freshness and roundness, with each selected terroir chosen for the uniqueness of its chardonnays contributing to the complexity of the blend.	150	
70. DOM PÉRIGNON VINTAGE Tour-sur-Marne France		
Dom Pérignon is the top cuvée from Moët & Chandon. It is named after Dom Pérignon, a Benedictine monk who was an important quality pioneer for Champagne wine but who, contrary to popular myths, did not discover the Champagne method for making sparkling wines. Dom Pérignon is always a vintage champagne, meaning that all grapes used to make the wine were harvested in the same year. The wine is not made in weak years, i.e. when the general quality of the harvest is considered to be too low. The earliest market release of a vintage is usually after 8-10 years.	250	
71. BELSTAR PROSECCO DOC  Veneto Italy		
Drive an hour or so north of Venice and you’ll find Valdobbiadene, where Gianluca Bisol’s winery is located. Bisol own all of their own vineyards and are recognised as one of the best producers of Prosecco in the region, from entry level to the iconic Cartizze Grand Cru.	7.5	44
72. GRAHAM BECK BRUT ROSÉ NV   Robertson South Africa		
Praised for its balance of flirtatious fruitiness and structured elegance. Versatile and suitable for any occasion. Its careful craftsmanship and high quality have earned it global recognition.	9	53
73. MIRABEAU LA FOLIE PROVENCE SPARKLING ROSÉ  Provence France		
Hailing from Luberon in central Provence, Mirabeau La Folie Sparkling Rosé is a delightful blend of Syrah, Grenache, and Cinsault grapes, with an elegant fruity character. It is the perfect apéritif and pairs beautifully with salads, seafood tapas and summer fruit desserts.	50	
74. GRAHAM BECK BLANC DE BLANCS 2017   Robertson South Africa		
After six months barrel fermentation, the second bottle fermentation takes four years. This is a very serious wine for not serious money. It’s won lots of awards and is served at state occasions for guests including Barack Obama and Nelson Mandela. It’s big, rich and full.	10.5	57
75. COATES & SEELY BRUT   Hampshire England		
A blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, with reserves from previous years, and lees-aged for 3 years to give depth and complexity. The Brut Reserve NV won the Best in Show Trophy in 2022’s Decanter World Wine Awards with a Platinum medal and a score of 97 points.	67	
76. BALFOUR LESLIE'S RESERVE BRUT ROSÉ   Kent England		
The winery is renowned for its pink wines, starting with the Balfour Brut Rosé, the first English wine served on BA flights, exclusive pour at the Olympics, and winner of the Gold Trophy at IWC. This Rosé Sparkling is its delightful sibling, embodying Balfour’s signature freshness and fruitiness. Anticipate vibrant notes of crunchy redcurrants and wild raspberries, complemented by fine bubbles crafted using the traditional method akin to champagne. At Balfour winery, texture is as important as fruit, exemplifying English winemaking's commitment to continual improvement and excellence. This wine also embodies Balfour's commitment to sustainability, exemplified by their latest initiative. Christian Peth and his wife Maja Luise lead the team at the Peth-Wetz winery, located between Worms and Alzey in Germany's Rheinhessen. Classic dry Rheinhessen style. Lovely and fragrant. Works really well with spicy dishes. Loves chilli, coriander, lime and lemongrass.	38		
10. A20 ALBARINO ⓘ Galicia Spain			
Situated in the heart of the infamous Golden Triangle, lies the mesmerising Stellenrust winery. Views over Table Mountain and the Cape winelands - this is their barrel fermented Chenin. Lovely, ripe and full of flavour from 55 year old vines.	47

18. REBELAND CHENIN BLANC ⓘ ⓘ Swartland South Africa			
Stellenbosch is a university town in South Africa's Western Cape province. It's surrounded by the vineyards of the Cape Winelands and the mountainous nature reserves. Made by our good friends at Journey's End winery in Stellenbosch from grapes sourced from the Swartland region, north of Cape Town.	31.5		
19. HAYSTACK CHARDONNAY ⓘ ⓘ Stellenbosch South Africa			
Possibly one of our favourite producers, not only for the wine they make but also for the work they do in supporting the local community. Nestled amongst the Schapenberg hills, beneath which lay 350 million year old decomposed granite soils. This creates one of the most prestigious terroirs in South Africa, and is where the vines are planted. As well as fantastic views, the vineyards benefit from the cooling and cleansing south-easterly wind, known locally as the 'Cape Doctor', which comes in from nearby False Bay and the Atlantic Ocean.	42		
20. BOURGOGNE ALIGOTE , DOMAINE ROUX PERE ET FILS ⓘ ⓘ Burgundy France			
This is simply a gorgeous wine. Made from the 'other' white grape variety in Burgundy. The nose carries tones of vanilla, apple, citrus, toasted almond, butterscotch and ripe fruit.	48

In the shadow of the alps from the village of Apremont, made from 100% Jacquere grapes. Never heard of it? You'll love it. Have it with grilled fish, cheese or as an aperitif.				47
26. PEDRA A PEDRA BRANCO , QUINTA DA PEDRA ⓘ Douro Portugal				
Pedra a Pedra Branco is a deliciously dry blend of two native Portuguese grape varieties – Rabigato and Gouveio. It has delicate citrus and tropical notes and a wonderful texture which sets it apart from other dry white wines. A marvellous partner to our fish dishes.				46
27. CA MAIOL PRESTIGE LUGANA TURBINA ⓘ Lombardy Italy				
Lugana is a hidden gem and has always been associated with a light, easy to drink wine, however, the appellation has started to produce more complex wines. 31. THE HUNTSMAN SHIRAZ-MOURVEDRE   Stellenbosch South Africa				
The Huntsman bears reference to the original Cape Hunt that was founded in 1822. With hounds imported from Gloucestershire, England, it has the distinction of being the oldest New World Hunt today. The Journey’s End winery occupies the site where the original kennels stood. Partner with red meats from the grill or in winter big beefy stews.				41
32. ZENSA PRIMITIVO    Puglia Italy				
Zensa, pronounced ‘senza’, by Italian definition means ‘without’. It’s a reference to their winemaking philosophy and practices, which are entirely organic and focus on as little human interference as possible. Low-yielding, fully organic vineyards in the Salento area of southern Puglia. An organic, vegan, fruit bomb. A Primitivo (Zinfandel) with attitude!	7.5	10.5	29.5	44

Full-bodied Douro red wine offering aromas and flavors of ripe dark fruits like blackberry, plum and cherry. The wine is known for its structure with a smooth, long, elegant finish that makes it a good match for roasted meats.				46

Prugneto is the name of the vineyard from which the grapes for this single-varietal Sangiovese come. This vineyard was the first to be purchased by the Ravaioli family and is still a reference for the wines of this region today. Drink with steaks, pasta, cheese, a fantastic all-rounder!				41
37. IRONSTONE ZINFANDEL  California USA				
The Lodi area is the centre of Californian Zinfandel grape growing with over 40% of the state’s production of the variety. The vines used here are over 45 years old and there’s a lot of wine here for the money. It’s a very versatile wine when food matching with pork, beef or game making particularly good pairings.				46
38. BROUILLY SELECTION DU BARON DE LA VAUXONNE GAMAY Beaujolais France				
Gamay from the southernmost and most extensive of the Beaujolais crus, at the very southern end of Burgundy, just south of Macon and north of Lyon. Bright and juicy. Likes to be very lightly chilled if it’s warm day. This is proper Beaujolais. Medal winner at the Sommelier Wine Awards.				50
39. BATTLE OF BOSWORTH CABERNET SAUVIGNON  McLaren Vale Australia				
Joch Bosworth’s winery is situated in the foothills of the Southern Mount Lofty Ranges and bound to the west by the pristine waters of the Gulf St Vincent, 25 miles south of Adelaide. This is the 18th version of the BoB Cabernet and is a stylish, classy, understated wine that shows wonderful varietal characteristics.				57

An Argentinian icon, in 2023 Catena was voted #1 Best Vineyard in South America and in the World. Family vintners for over 100 years, the Catenas are recognised for their pioneering role in high-altitude viticulture and in leading Argentina’s Malbec revolution. RITME (rhythm) is a wine produced from a selection of exceptional old vineyards in the Priorat region, two hours south west of Barcelona. The blend is based only on native, indigenous varieties, 45% Carinyena and 55% Garnacha. Robert Parker gave this vintage 91 points. If you enjoy Malbec then please give this a try.				57
44. SPRINGFIELD WORK OF TIME BORDEAUX BLEND  Robertson South Africa				
After two years of barrel maturation followed by a further four years of bottle maturation, finally the wine is released, hence the name. From the hot day, cool night wine region of Robertson, the wine is rich, deep, concentrated and complex.				60

Produced at the Seival Estate by the Miolo family, this is a brilliant example of the new wave of outstanding wines coming out of Campanha in Southern Brazil. Rich dark fruit flavours, hints of dark chocolate, spice and a smooth elegant finish.	6	9	25	35
46. TOMAS CUSINE VILOSELL TEMPRANILLO  Catalunya Spain				
At their winery is a little over an hour away from Barcelona, the guys at Tomas Cusine have created this wine, Vilosell, from 50% Tempranillo and equal measures of Shiraz and Grenache. It’s like Rioja meets the Rhone Valley. Delicious.				51
47. ALTOS DE JOSE IGNACIO RESERVE TANNAT   Maldonado Uruguay				
From the coastal town of Jose Ignacio and made at the fantastic Garzon winery, Uruguay loves Tannat the same way Argentina loves Malbec. Both Tannat and Malbec originate from South West France. Drink this with a steak or any meat straight off the grill.				51

The Remirez Blanco consists of 70% Viura and 30% Malvasia from vines between 60 and 80 years old.		
86. CLOUDY BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC  Marlborough New Zealand		80
Kevin Judd launched Cloudy Bay in 1985 to international acclaim, with a Sauvignon Blanc that put New Zealand wine on the map. The winery brought New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc to world-wide attention in the 1980s when its first vintages were reviewed by British wine writer Oz Clarke, who wrote that their New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is “arguably the best in the world”.		
87. FORGE CELLARS FINGER LAKES RIESLING New York State USA		80
A superb, bone dry and earthy Riesling from the Finger Lakes region of New York State. A small, artisanal winery set up by French winemaker Louis Barruol of Chateau Saint Cosme in the Rhone. A different style to Alsace, German or Antipodean versions; they keep the sugar levels right down so their wines can justly be described ‘bone’ dry. This is actually quite a weighty example and has lovely complex spice and earthy notes.

Château la Nerthe is a stunning, 500-year-old property becoming ‘one to watch’ in recent years. Davide Rosso took over from his father, Giovanni, in the early 2000s. He has since risen quickly in reputation as one of Piedmont’s greatest producers. He may not have the uninterrupted winemaking history of some of his famous neighbours, but he is the envy of many: he has some of the most desirable vineyards in Barolo – Serralunga d’Alba, Cerretta, Serra – showcasing the vivid terroir of his beloved hometown.
